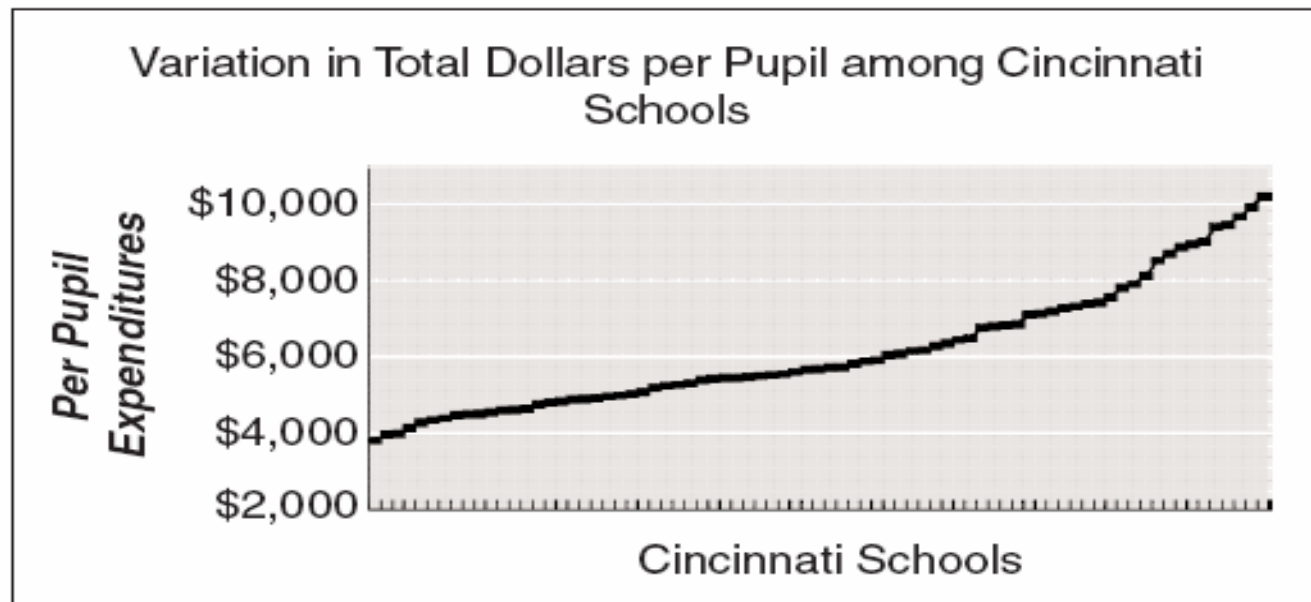


While Cincinnati's **wealthiest schools** are able to spend more than **\$13,500** per pupil, poor neighborhoods, like **OVER-THE-RHINE**, spend only **\$3500** per child.
